SEAL OF THE COLUMBIAN COLLEGE



In 1819, the Reverend Luther Rice, Obadiah B. Brown, Spencer H. Cone, and Enoch Reynolds (all Baptist ministers) set in motion the reality of a college in the District. These men raised the needed funds to purchase land in the nation's capital, petitioned the Congress for a charter, and began organizing a college.

On February 9, 1821, President James Monroe signed the Act of Congress which created the College. By design of the Congress, a special provision was included which required that “persons of every religious denomination shall be capable of being elected Trustees; nor shall any person, either as President, Professor, Tutor or pupil, be refused admittance, or denied any of the privileges, immunities, or advantages thereof, for or on account of his sentiments in matters of religion.”

The original seal was designed by James Peale in 1821, at the time of the founding of the Columbian College. This is the seal that the graduates are wearing today as medals. The seal features a Biblical lion lying down with a lamb and Greek text in an open book. The Greek translates to “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God.”

In 1873, the name Columbian College was changed to Columbian University and the seal was changed slightly to reflect this. The Latin text around the outside was changed from “Columbiani Collegii” to “Universitatis Columbianae Sigillum.” In addition, some text was added to fill up the rest of the open book, since the Greek phrase only took up part of one page. In 1905, after the name changed to the George Washington University, the old seal was replaced by a completely new one.

The original Columbian College seal is currently on display in the Memorabilia Room of Gelman Library.

Baylee Bogard from Newport Beach, Calif., was a criminal justice major and communication minor. She interned at the Vogel Group, a bipartisan D.C. lobbying firm, and was a member of GW Mock Trial and Phi Alpha Delta where she explored the intersection between communication and public policy. Baylee also led a group of peers through a GW externship with the St. Johns County Clerk of Court to devise a branding strategy for the rollout of new county initiatives. Baylee's leadership and service as a thought-partner led to successful outcomes for the Floridian community and the cultivation of a flourishing partnership for GW.

ROBERT W. KENNY PRIZE FOR INNOVATION IN TEACHING OF INTRODUCTORY COURSES

The Robert W. Kenny Prize for Innovation in Teaching of Introductory Courses is awarded annually to a faculty member in the Columbian College of Arts and Sciences who has shown innovation, creativity, and originality in teaching an introductory course in the Arts and Sciences. The recipient, who is among the most talented of our teachers, teaches an introductory or basic course during the academic year in a novel and innovative way. Professors receiving this award have encouraged their students to think differently, allowing them to take advantage of their academic experience at the George Washington University. The Kenny Prize honors former Dean Robert Kenny and his special dedication to stimulating experiences for GW students and his emphasis on the importance of introductory courses as students undertake their studies in the liberal arts and sciences.

Nicole Bartels

Teaching Assistant Professor, Political Science

Nicole Bartels earned her BA at Union College and MA in Political Science from Ohio State University where she studied American politics with a concentration on race, gender and ethnicity, and the legislative branch. She served as a legislative assistant for a member of Congress, working on legislation relating to military affairs, health care, the U.S. Postal Service and education.. In 2018, she joined the faculty at GW, where she teaches Introduction to American Government, Women & Politics, the American Presidency, Campaigns & Elections and Race & Ethnic Politics. In addition to teaching, Dr. Bartels has mentored numerous students as an internship and thesis advisor. She takes great pride in helping students in and out of the classroom achieve their goals and make meaningful connections in the D.C. region.

Danika Myers

Teaching Assistant Professor of Writing

Danika Myers has been a full-time member of the University Writing Program faculty since 2008. In addition to teaching GW's First Year Writing seminar, UW1020, she has worked with GW programs and departments, such as The Instructional Core, to promote a culture of writing across GW and support research-based practices in teaching. Dr. Myers holds a MFA in poetry from GW. Her poetry has appeared in a number of journals, including Beloit Poetry Journal and Harlot: A Revealing Look at the Arts of Persuasion. She has been recognized for her work in Meridian and other poetry journals, and was awarded a Fulbright Fellowship to study literary translation in Quito, Ecuador.

THE COLUMBIAN PRIZE FOR TEACHING AND MENTORING ADVANCED UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

The Columbian Prize for Teaching and Mentoring Advanced Undergraduate Students is awarded to a regular, full-time faculty member in the Columbian College of Arts and Sciences who demonstrates excellence in the teaching and mentoring of advanced undergraduate students. With this prize, we recognize exceptional achievement in one or more of the following areas of work: teaching an advanced undergraduate course, advising students, directing undergraduate research, designing a capstone experience, or mentoring students who achieve departmental honors and other distinctions.

Jameta Barlow

Assistant Professor of Writing, Health Policy and Management, and WGSS

Jameta Barlow, PhD, MPH, is a community health psychologist and actively involved in the GW Women's Leadership Program. Her research utilizes decolonizing methodologies to disrupt cardiometabolic syndrome and structural policies adversely affecting Black girls' and women's health. With professional experiences in the federal government, national nonprofits and academia, she has transdisciplinary collaborations with physicians, public health practitioners, researchers, policy administrators, activists, political appointees, and community members that she brings into the classroom and advising. Her book, *Writing Blackgirls' and Women's Health and Science: Implications for Policy and Practice*, was co-authored with students.

Axel Schmidt

Assistant Professor, Physics

Axel Schmidt grew up in Pittsburgh, PA, and is a proud alumnus of the Pittsburgh Public Schools. He received his B.S. in physics in 2009 from Yale University, where he had the privilege of being supported in undergraduate research through Yale University's Particle Accelerator Memorial Project. He received his PhD in physics in 2016 from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, working on nuclear physics research at the "Deutsches Elektronen Synchrotron" particle accelerator facility in Hamburg, Germany. Professor Schmidt joined the faculty at GW in 2020. His current research is conducted at the Thomas Jefferson National Accelerator Facility, as well as other accelerators around the world.

THE LUTHER RICE UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS

Established by the Dean of the Columbian College in 2003, the Luther Rice Undergraduate Research Fellowships are designed to encourage and support research projects initiated by undergraduate students and performed under the mentorship of faculty sponsors. Luther Rice, one of four founders of the original Columbian College, which grew to become the George Washington University, was known for his tenacity of spirit and integrity of intellect. In this spirit, the Luther Rice Undergraduate Research Fellowships are intended to support critical inquiry and intellectual honesty through practical support of student research.
